

2020-2021 REOPENING PLAN

ENSURING SAFETY

Upon arrival...

- All staff/students/visitors will be requested to wear a face covering in accordance with the CDC guidelines
- Staff & students will be temperature screened
- COVID-19 questionnaire administered
- Asked to wash or sanitize hands upon entry to school

Indoor Classrooms

- Masks worn at all times
- Students distanced by seating arrangements
- Hands sanitized upon classroom entry
- When students will move classrooms, teachers will disinfect desks and high touch surfaces after each class change.
- Students will not be permitted to help with the sanitizing process.

Hallway/Common Spaces/Restrooms

- Masks worn at all times
- Designate one-way traffic flow, stairwells as up or down, posting directional reminders on the floors and walls.
- Students distanced by floor markers, respecting 6ft social distancing
- Working to install touchless soap dispensers, bottle fillers on second and third floor, bathroom doors to remain propped open or installing foot pull at bottom of the door
- Electrostatic fogging of all classrooms every Friday

IN PERSON LEARNING

Abbreviated Days and Less Students on Campus

- 3rd-5th graders will be on campus Monday-Thursday from roughly 9:00-2:00.
- Class sizes are 10 or less.
- 6th-8th graders will be split into two groups. This will allow these classes to be 10 or less. Group 1 will be on campus Monday and Wednesday and Group 2 will be on campus Tuesday and Thursday.
- A shortened day and week allows additional time for cleaning and for teachers to have time to prepare for distance learning.
- Allow students/families to self-identify as high risk for severe illness due to COVID-19 and have a plan in place to address requests for alternative learning arrangements.

MEALS

Breakfast

- Send breakfast items home with students
- Individually wrapped items available onsite when needed to be served in classrooms

Lunch

- Masks worn while lunch is being served
- Hands sanitized/washed before food is served
- Students distanced by floor markers, respecting 6 feet social distancing
- Student plates will only be handled by food service workers
- All condiments will be individual packages
- Utensils and napkins will be individually wrapped
- Students will be encouraged to eat outside when possible
- When eating indoors, students will socially distance 6 feet as marked on seats.
- Schedule will stagger use of cafeteria space with cleaning in between.
- Face mask may be removed while eating and put back on once finished
- Discontinue use of self-serve meals/snacks

Weekend
